To be considered for OHDCC office, members must:

- Intend to enroll in the Social-Organizational Psychology Program at least part-time for the 2016-2017 academic year (MA, PhD, ELDP, and XMA candidates welcome)
- Submit required application materials
- Be a dues paying member

All details relevant to the election process will be shared at the March 3rd Presidential Information Session, located in URIS 328 (Columbia Business School) from 5:30pm to 6:30pm. The presentation shared at this event will be made available on the OHDCC website immediately following the event.

The election process moves quickly, so potential candidates should begin preparing a brief statement on their behalf to share with voting OHDCC members. Think about who you are, why you came to the program, your hopes for OHDCC, and how you envision us getting there. More detailed prompts and parameters of candidate statements will be presented March 3rd.

March 7th - Deadline to declare candidacy for 2016-2017 OHDCC President

March 24th - **Presidential Debates** (*Online ballot opened immediately after debate*)

March 27th - Presidential ballot closed and counted

March 28st - 2016-2017 OHDCC President announced

The Election Timeline: Vice Presidents

March 28th - Deadline to apply for a 2016-2017 OHDCC Vice President position. There are four positions available:

- VP of Member Engagement
- VP of Professional Development
- VP of Alumni Engagement
- VP of Budget

March 30th - Online ballot opened to OHDCC members for voting

April 1st - Vice Presidential ballot closed and counted
